We require the presence of a parent or care giver at our sessions because our program is not just about having fun. It is about giving parents and children a real fighting chance in a struggling school system that places far too little value in early childhood development and developmental learning. Classes are held once a week and are free. A donation is always welcome and helps keep the
